

VISIONING QUESTIONS

You Matter: Your input is crucial in this process!

Take your time and answer as many of these questions as you can. Your feedback will be an amazing help as we lay the groundwork for a Capital Campaign.

Please return your responses to the church office by July 2.

1. Begin by prayerfully and gratefully listing the strengths of All Saints.
 - 2a. Now brainstorm the unmet or unfunded needs **you** know of that, if they were met and funded, would make a significant difference in the congregation's future. Let your imagination be a servant of God's Spirit. Think, dream, imagine the "What ifs?" of ministry here at All Saints.
 - 2b. What are ministry opportunities we could address or expand but are not doing so at present (children, youth, young, median, and senior adults, Christian education, music, outreach both local and beyond All Saints, etc.)?
 - 2c. What are the unaddressed or ignored facility needs we have put off. (This may include deferred maintenance, lack of space, parking, accessibility issue, Christian education space, music space, etc.)

3. Reflect on all the answers above and ask: How could we meet these needs and seize these opportunities? Answer the first things that come to your mind. You'll get into detail in the following questions.

3a. How would our facilities need to change if we focused on those new ministries in 2 and 3?

3b. What NEW facilities, property, or equipment would be required if we addressed the ministry needs and opportunities in 2 and 3?

3c. If the All Saints' HVAC debt (\$289,000 remaining of the original \$316,000) were paid off, what ministries could be enhanced or begun if All Saints were free of that monthly obligation?
